- and interacting with our guests to ensure a positive guest experience


In addition, you attended seminars covering a wide variety of topics, to enable you to better comprehend the many aspects of our business.



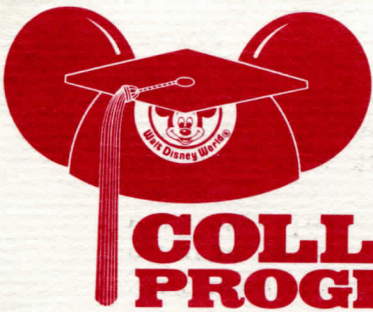
