California Clergy Required To Report Child Abuse

LOS ANGELES, Calif. (EP) — Clergy in California are not exempt from a state law requiring child care providers to report suspected child abuse, a municipal judge has ruled.

Arthur E. Hodges, pastor of the South Bay Pentecostal Church, and George E. Nobbs, assistant pastor, say they acted as clergymen, not child care providers, when they counseled a molestation victim who was a student at the church's school, and the daughter of one of the church's lay preachers.
