1987 was the show's 39th year of broadcast. The two-hour weekly program featured host Will Regan in adjacent studio with double pane glass partition. Clint Dantine directed every aspect of the live show from the control room. This included airing commercials and music, utilizing additional microphones for guest interviews, airing weekly Irish sports brief with Tom Farley, and patching via telephone mix/minus interface guest interviews long distance directly from Ireland.

1988 was both WVCH radio station and "WILL REGAN IRISH HOURS" 40TH anniversary year. Clint Dantine assisted in the station celebration history and promotions.

Clint was referred to as a radio prodigy as in 1987 he was still a junior in high school -- and Will's "Ed McMahon"

NOTE: WEEE was a new station which first went on the air in April 1987 under the ownership of Tom Harvey Moffit. Clint Dantine was essential to the inaugural broadcast team. He primarily worked the Sunday evening shift. He was in his junior year of high school and considered a radio prodigy when hired in 1987.

On December 31, 1989 Clint Dantine hosted the New Year's Countdown live on-air taking listeners into the new decade.
