

NEW ACTIVITIES - Next year's student council must create new activities to meet the varied interests of Mount Pleasant students. We propose the following:

1. A student-run, low power radio station. Already in existence in a public school fifteen miles from here, a student-run station here would open up opportunities to students interested in broadcasting, public speaking and engineering, and would serve as a unifying force within our district.

2. A repertory theater. Students from all three classes will join together in a production company to present community performances of plays regularly. This program would be in addition to our already existing class plays.

3. A Carnival. This idea, which was favored by the student body in a questionnaire this year, will be carried out next year. With advance planning this event should be both enjoyable and financially rewarding.

4. A Free Dance. To encourage attendance at our regular school dances, we propose that the first or second dance of the year be without admission charge. We believe that this idea would be a sound investment toward a better attendance at our regular dances.

5. Two New Clubs. Clubs will be investigated for sailing and skiing enthusiasts. With student support these clubs could go on field trips alone or with the clubs of other schools

6. A series of "Talk-Ins". This would be an extra curricular program involving speakers and discussion groups on subjects of the students' choice.

7. A literary magazine. In order to give students a chance to express their ideas for publication, we suggest that a magazine be printed regularly, including such things as poetry and short stories.

8. An industrial and fine arts show. This exhibit for student projects and works would be held at the end of the school year. Prizes could be awarded to increase the interest in this show.

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
