Thank you for your letter of recent date telling me of the progress you are making on the Mt. Pleasant Educational FM Radio Station. I note you have filed an application with the FCC for a construction permit. I hope it will soon be granted.

With reference to the initiation of the Public Broadcasting Act of 1967, it is my understanding that Mr. Frank Pace, Jr., President of the International Service Corporation, 548 Madison Avenue, New York, New York, 10002, has been made Chairman of the Board of Directors for the Public Broadcasting Corporation. However, the government has not approved any monies as yet. I think there has been some monies from foundation grants, but before the program can be put in full operation it will require Federal funds.
